RELIGIOUS SCIENCE teaches that there is a principle of right action. You can observe this constructive principle at work everywhere. Paul said, "... your conversation is in heaven." (Philippians 3:20.) He did not mean that you should be sanctimonious. He meant that you should be constructive in your thinking. Always think of yourself as being in the right place at the right time with the right people and the right money. Reverse any suggestion that you are too late to receive the good that you are entitled to. Reverse the thought that you are too old or too young. Do not permit any thought to cause you to give power to something outside of Divine Principle.

Perfect right action is the law. It operates for you. It works through you, but you must know this and accept it with conviction.

REALITY AND YOUR LIFE . . . Lesson Three . . . EXPRESSING YOUR REAL SELF

THE FACE on the television screen was distorted by a wavy motion that continually changed the shape and proportions. Obviously this was not the way the singer really looked. There was interference of some kind — in the transmission, in the atmosphere, or in the set. The difficulty was not in the origin of the picture. Nor was it in the screen because sometimes the picture would be clear and in focus. The cause of the distortion had to be in the *medium* of expression.

In the preceding lesson we discussed Divine identity — your God-created Real Self — that which in truth you are, to give, do and be. Now, the purpose of Life must be to fulfill Itself. Thus the prime purpose in each of us must be to give full expression to the Real Self.

How can we tell when the expression is true and when it is distorted? In the case of the television image we recognize the distortion because we know the general characteristics of head and body and that they do not change from moment to moment. In the case of the Self we have no such criteria. We must look to qualities that are

intrinsic in a Divine idea and therefore inherent in the Self: wholeness, vitality of spirit, mind and body, internal harmony, love — all the means necessary for complete expression and progressive unfoldment.

Look at a particular experience that is appearing on the screen of your life. If the Divine qualities (and none of their opposites) are present, you know that what is appearing is an undistorted expression of your Real Self, an individualization of your true and unique identity. If any of these qualities are distorted or lacking, what must be changed to clear the picture? Not your Real Self, for it is the flawless creation of God. Not the screen of life, for it simply reflects.

The distortion has to be in the *medium* of expression — and that medium is subjective mind. The distortion is in the form of subjectified misconception, mistaken belief, prejudice and obsession.

You can clear the distortion by the consistent use of spiritual mind treatment — and enjoy expressing your Real Self.
