DR. ERNEST HOLMES is quoted to have said, when someone wanted to talk with him about his philosophy, "If you cannot posit the primacy of Spirit, our conversation would be a waste of time for both of us." This was not rudeness or lack of interest in confronting the question of the existence of God. It was an attitude of polite concern for both the individual and the Principle of Universal Being. Dr. Holmes understood that there was no necessity to prove the existence of God; rather, the necessity was that the individual should learn to perceive the Divine Presence.

Since we would not want to close the door on the human endeavor to understand increasingly more about the universe in which we live, it becomes necessary to be pliable or receptive enough to see into areas other than our own circumscribed existence. Dr. Holmes knew that

he could share his understanding of Divine Mind only with a person who had an open mind and not with someone who was looking for an argument.

Scientists provide us with an intelligent format in the use of hypothesis or theory. We should not limit the application of this format to the physical sciences. The very idea of God as infinite Being should arouse our interest in the relationship of God to ourselves and its meaning in our lives.

Some individuals dismiss any sense of personal responsibility about God, citing names of religious persons and institutions which function inefficiently or dogmatically. However, these same human deficiencies are overlooked in secular organizations in whose activity they are interested. Perhaps these individuals do not realize that their expression of disbelief in God reveals their lack of interest in what is an irrefutable Principle.

The Principle needs no defense. It needs only those who are courageous enough to stand unapologetically upon It. We might ask ourselves, "Am I scientific enough to 'posit the primacy of Spirit' as the basis for an unparalleled spiritual adventure?"

REALITY AND YOUR LIFE Lesson Four REALISTIC GOALS

JANE was learning to walk again after months of recuperation from a nerve injury. It was a slow, painful process. Her tendency was to watch each foot and each crutch, and make each forward move consciously. Fortunately she had a wise and experienced nurse who knew that concentration on separate motions caused clumsy, awkward movement. She also knew the importance of realistic goals and how to achieve them.

Jane was taught to reach as far as she could with her imagination and then, with her eyes on the goal, to move in that direction. At first it taxed her credulity to think of getting to the chair across the room. But with her vision on the goal, she made it. Then she stretched her vision to the bench at the end of the hall — and discovered that her crutches, legs and feet followed along. Her subconscious mind, free of interference, was producing and coordinating the action necessary to arrive at the goal. With each success Jane, in her imagination, was able to reach higher levels of achievement. Action followed subconsciously. Finally the ultimate goal of actually walking naturally

and normally was attained.

This case illustrates two basic principles of goal achievement. The first is that your goal must be realistic. The sole criterion for a realistic goal is an affirmative answer to the question: “Can I, by stretching, but not straining, imagine myself being there in both action and feeling?” Whether or not what you envision has been attained before is of no consequence. Divine Mind is not bound by precedent. Opinions of others as to what you can or cannot do matter not. Only you, within your own thought and feeling, can know the limit of your present reach.

The second principle is: Let Mind, as your subconscious, produce and coordinate the action. While it is necessary to cooperate as action unfolds, attempts to consciously direct it interfere with its innate efficiency.

Maintain the vision of your goal vital and strong in your consciousness. Then watch with wonder the way Mind moves you to your destination — where a new and greater realistic goal can be chosen.
