**V**ISUALIZE the beautiful bridge that spans the mile-wide Golden Gate. It is so finely designed that it looks like lace, yet it withstands gales of over a hundred miles an hour. Can you imagine Joseph Strauss, when planning the structure, saying, "We'll throw some steel and concrete together, and with good luck we'll have a bridge."? Hardly. His reliance was not on guesswork and luck but on principle, the principle of design and sound engineering. He did not dash around in a hit-or-miss, haphazard fashion, with hope that somehow things would work out. Rather, he proceeded with the only true creative process, the only certain way to bring an idea into desired expression. He dreamed his dream until it became a reality to him, until he could walk across the bridge in his mind. Then with strict adherence to the principles of design and engineering, of order and sequence, and of natural law, he cooperated with the evolution of his idea as it took on substance and outward form. Then he walked across the bridge in fact.

Contrast this to the approach that many people have toward dream fulfillment: "When my ship comes in—"; "I need a lucky break—"; "If I could only guess the right answer, or pick the right horse!" This sort of thinking arises from a belief that conditions govern one's experience. If they are favorable the dream can come true; if unfavorable there is disappointment and frustration.

Some followers of metaphysics are heard to say (in essence), "I'll throw a few positive ideas together with a little faith, and with good luck I'll have a demonstration." The person who trusts to luck and guesswork in any area stands anxiously on the shifting and unstable sands of circumstance. The one who trusts in principle stands securely on the solid rock of law.

The principle of the creative process is that an image which becomes real in thought is translated into action by the Law of Mind. There is no luck, no guesswork involved.
