Before you give your treatment, you have a definite idea in mind. You know what your treatment is going to be, and you proceed to speak your treatment into form. You are simply putting into operation a law of mind. Your treatment will manifest itself because that is the way in which the principle works.

You start your mental creative work much sooner than you are likely to realize. When you start your mental work the creative cycle is already working. "Before they call I have heard." The formal treatment represents the consummation in your mind of what you want. Realize that it is the action of the one mind doing its perfect work now. Your treatment commences to act even before you consciously give it, for subconsciously we are always moving toward what we want.
